The Anson County Board of Education met in regular session on Monday,
December 16, 2013. All members were present. Others in attendance were
Howard McLean (Executive Director), Holly Berry (Chief Financial Officer), Mary Ratliff (Executive Director), Mike
Flake (Board Attorney) and Anne Hyatt (Board Clerk).

A. Call to Order

Michael Freeman opened the meeting and welcomed all visitors.

B. Policy 2200 (Election of Officers/Organization of Board)

Superintendent Freeman explained the process of the election of officers and asked for nominations for Chair perso n. George Truman nominated Lisa Davis and Russell Sikes seconded the nomination. Carol Gibson made a motion that nominations be closed. The motion was seconded by George Truman and the board voted unanimously to elect

Lisa Davis as Chairperson. Motions carried.

George Truman nominated Bobbie Little for Vice Chairperson. Russell Sikes seconded the nomination. Carol Gibson made a motion that nominations be closed. The motion was seconded by Russell Sikes and the board voted unanimously to elect Bobbie Little as Vice Chairperson. Motions carried.

D. Conflict of Interest Statement
