# Minutes Anson County Board of Education Regular Meeting

Monday, November 23, 2009, 5:30 p.m.

The Anson County Board of Education met in regular session Monday, November 23, 2009. All members were present except for an excused absence from Altheria Patton and Lisa Davis. Others in attendance were Frances Williamson (Deputy Superintendent), Michael Freeman (Executive Director), Michael McLeod (Executive Director for Individual and Organizational Accountability), Mike Flake (Board Attorney), and Anne Hyatt (Clerk to the Board of Education).

# I. Call to Order

One student said they primarily used PowerPoint but they also used a webpage to showcase and build their program. The ANTHS students said the webpage they developed would help carry out their program.

- <u>Annual Financial Report</u>: Evan Reeves was present from Reeves and Associates to give an overview of the annual financial report. Mr. Reeves said if any members had questions, they could call him directly.
- Tetra Data: Gina Magaruh and Michael McLeod were present to give an update on the work that is happening with Tetra Data. Dr. Firn began by explaining that Tetra Data gathers information, stores it and analyzes it. He said this will help the system to find out what is going on from student performance to transportation. He said it will help the system to be more efficient and effective in the business of teaching and learning. Ms. Magaruh and Mr. McLeod showed a live presentation to the board. Ms. Magaruh said there is a Discipline System, a Student Information System, an HR System and a Financial System and each system has a multitude of reporting functions. She explained this system will help to analyze data very seamlessly.
