Anson County Board of Education Regular Meeting Monday, January 29, 2024, 4:00 p.m. Anson County Schools' Administrative Conference Room/Board Room

The Anson County Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, January 29, 2024. Board members present were Marilynn Bennett, Lisa Davis, Carol Gibson, Frank Liles, Dr. Bobbie Little, Judy Little, Beulah Pratt, George Truman, and Mike Turner. Call to Order

Educational Partners International

Dr. McLaurin was present to speak about Educational Partners International (EPI) and introduced Dr. David Long (EPI Director of Placement) to also share information about EPI.
