The Anson County Board of Education met in a regular session on Monday, August 25, 2025. Board leaders present were Marilynn Bennett (Virtual), Lisa Davis, Carol Gibson, Frank Liles, Bobbie Little (Virtual), Judy Little, Beulah Pratt, Kelly Sheppard, and George Truman. Call to Order

Dr. George Truman called the meeting to order at 5:03 p.m. and welcomed everyone.

Superintendent's Report

<u>Audit Presentation</u>: Mr. Nick Wicker (Director of Governmental Services with Strickland Hardee PLLC) was present to share the 2023-2024 audit presentation. Mr. Wicker thanked the Board and staff for their cooperation. The Board expressed appreciation for his service and professionalism.

<u>Opening of School</u>: Dr. Ratliff said he had meaningful conversations with our students today and highlighted student excitement, staff dedication, and areas for continued improvement. Dr. Ratliff expressed appreciation for staff and board members who attended convocation, open houses, and opening events. He emphasized the theme: "Public School Communities are Priceless" and shared plans for continued strategic planning and school improvement efforts, with a focus on actionable goals and professional learning communities (PLCs).

Dr. Ratliff introduced Dr. Tharp (Executive Director of Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment). Dr. Ratliff highlighted his experience in professional learning communities, school improvement, and leadership as a high school principal. Dr. Tharp shared observations from visiting Anson High School, Anson Early College and the Transportation Department and praised their leadership and student engagement. He emphasized the role of Curriculum and Instruction staff in supporting (not burdening) principals.
