In-person instruction will take place Monday – Thursday with Fridays being remote for all learners. The district will deep clean all facilities on Fridays to safely prepare for the transition of student cohorts.

- K-5 teachers will stream lessons for in-person, remote cohorts, and 100% virtual students from 9:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. Lunch will also be served during this time.
- In-person cohorts will depart from school at 12:30 p.m.
- K-5 teachers will provide additional instructional support, office hours, and remote instruction from 1:00 – 3:00 p.m.
