Anson County Board of Education Special Meeting

Wednesday, January 10, 2018, 9:00 a.m. Anson County Schools' Administrative Office Board Room

The Anson County Board of Education met in special session on Wednesday, January 10, 2018. All members were present except for an excused absence from Frank Liles. I. Call to Order

Mike Flake then distributed ballot cards for the members to vote on the two nominations. After the voting, Mr. Flake confirmed Ms. Gay Lookabill won the vacant seat with a 5-1 vote.
