The Anson County Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, July 27, 2015. All members were present. Others in attendance were Michael Freeman (Superintendent), Howard McLean (Associate Superintendent), Marty Godwin (Assistant Superintendent), Holly Berry (Chief Financial Officer), Mike Flake (Board Attorney) and Anne Hyatt (Board Clerk).

I. **Call to Order**

Chair Bobbie Little opened the meeting and welcomed all visitors.

II. Invocation

Chair Little asked Lisa Davis to give the Invocation.

Conflict of Interest Statement III.

In compliance with the requirements of Chapter 138A-15(e) of the State Government Ethics Act, Chair Little reminded Board Members of their duty to avoid conflicts of interest and appearances of conflicts of interest under Chapter 138A. There were no conflicts of interest communicated by the members. Chair Little then requested that if, during the course of the meeting, members became aware of an actual or apparent conflict of interest that they bring the matter to her attention. Mr. Freeman gave a report on the Budget, Personnel, Current Job Postings, Community Use of Facilities, Current Projects Update and Instructional Programs.

During the superintendent's report, Carol Gibson asked for the number of students that reside in Anson County but attend private schools. Mr. Freeman said he would get that information to the board.

Additionally, Mr. Freeman explained the blended services approach at Anson High School and Anson New Technology High School beginning with the 2015-16 school year. He said that every child and every student will reap the benefits of every adult that is there to serve them. He further commented that he is very excited about the educational opportunities for all students attending AHS and ANTHS. Mr. Freeman said in utilizing the Blended Services Model, each student will have the benefit of earning their education by tapping into resources available at each school as they begin sharing the same campus on August 24th when school year begins. He discussed examples of the blended services to be provided such as, course offerings, school counseling, child & family support team, transportation, clerical support, school resource officers, athletics, media services, child nutrition, testing & assessment, focused learning lab, driver education program and school administration. Mr. Freeman concluded his dialogue by saying there will be more details shared as we near the start of school.

XI. Consent Items

Upon a motion by Mike Turner, seconded by Lisa Davis, the following consent items were approved by the board (Personnel Report, Community Use of Facilities Fee Structure and Title I and Title II Spending Plans.) Motion carried.

XII. New Business

Upon a motion by Lisa Davis, seconded by Marilynn Bennett, the board approved for administration to submit training credit hours to the NC School Boards Association for board members to receive credit for the Economic Development Summit (5.5 hours) and the Facilities Review Project (3.0 hours). Motion carried.
